Pursuant to provisions contained in Chapter 131, Section 13 of the Massachusetts General Laws the above-named institution has been approved for the issuance, free of charge, of a special fish certificate.

Such approval is granted in accordance with the determination that the issuance of said certificate is an appropriate activity to promote interest or understanding of fish, fishing and fish utilization by individuals who have never been introduced to this most relaxing therapeutic treatment.

This special certificate shall permit groups of patients, designated by facility authorities, to fish in inland waters of the Commonwealth without possessing sporting or fishing licenses. Such groups shall be limited to not more than fifteen patients each day from any one facility and each such group shall be under the supervision of a staff member of the facility. Said certificate shall be carried on the person of the staff member while the group is fishing and shall be shown upon demand to any officer empowered to enforce the provisions of chapter 131, M.G.L.. It is also understood that all participants must adhere to and abide by all other limitations and restrictions of law relative to Chapter 131.
